Dear Parents/Carers

To help promote our school's efforts to remain as eco-friendly as possible, and to ensure essential information reaches you as quickly as possible, we are moving towards electronic platforms for sharing school letters/memos etc.

We are currently using email as our primary pathway of correspondence. We would, however, like to simplify this by developing a Jonesborough notification category linked to our school website, and use this as our new method of communication.

The website would alert parents that information has been sent. Parents can then assess this correspondence directly from their phones/device.

To facilitate this, we need our families to consent to this feature. You can do this via the information attached with the Data collection forms (sent to you this week).

We urge parents to complete the data collection forms and essential permission correspondence as soon as possible, to allow us to share photos of school activities and arrange other educational activities.

These forms can easily be completed electronically and returned using most smart phones, tablets or computer. It is not necessary to print the forms.

We would also like to remind parents, if your child/ren are walking home unsupervised, it is imperative that the school receives written or email permission on or before the day they plan to walk.

As part of our child protection, we are required to hold children in school until a parent collects them or we receive written permission.
